Step 1: Sign up at projectindy.net

Go to <u>http://projectindy.net/</u> and click on the youth signup.



Note: Use the same email as used for Job Ready Indy.

Step 2: Check Your Email to Verify Account

Check your email for a message from WorkHere to confirm your WorkHere account. Project Indy runs on the WorkHere platform.



Step 3: Discover Employers in the Project Indy Network

- Click on the Networks tab and search for Project Indy
- 2. Hit **Follow** on the Project Indy Network to save it to your profile.

The Project Indy network contains all employers hiring Project Indy youth. The closest ones are shown first.

Step 6: Browse the Map for Nearby Employers

When you view the map there are 3 types of employers:



Tap on logos on the map to view active employers that participate in Project Indy



Blue dots are also employers with jobs but aren't active in the Project Indy



Gray dots are employers without any online job posts



Step 7: Follow Places You're Interested In

Once you've found a place you're interested in working at, hit Follow to save it.

Following places will add them to your profile and also let the hiring manager know that you're interested. (If they like your profile, they might reach out to you - but the best thing to do is APPLY for a job.)
